
**SEPTEMBER—NOVEMBER-** Individual appointments with UCAS Advisers to discuss applications.

University and careers representatives as well as past pupils are available tonight for informal discussions. Over the next few months, students will be encouraged to visit universities on their open days so that they can gather information about specific courses, meet lecturers and generally get a feel for the place.

The UCAS procedure will be explained thoroughly and pastoral support is available at any stage of the process. Use of the internet and the UCAS website will also be encouraged.
