



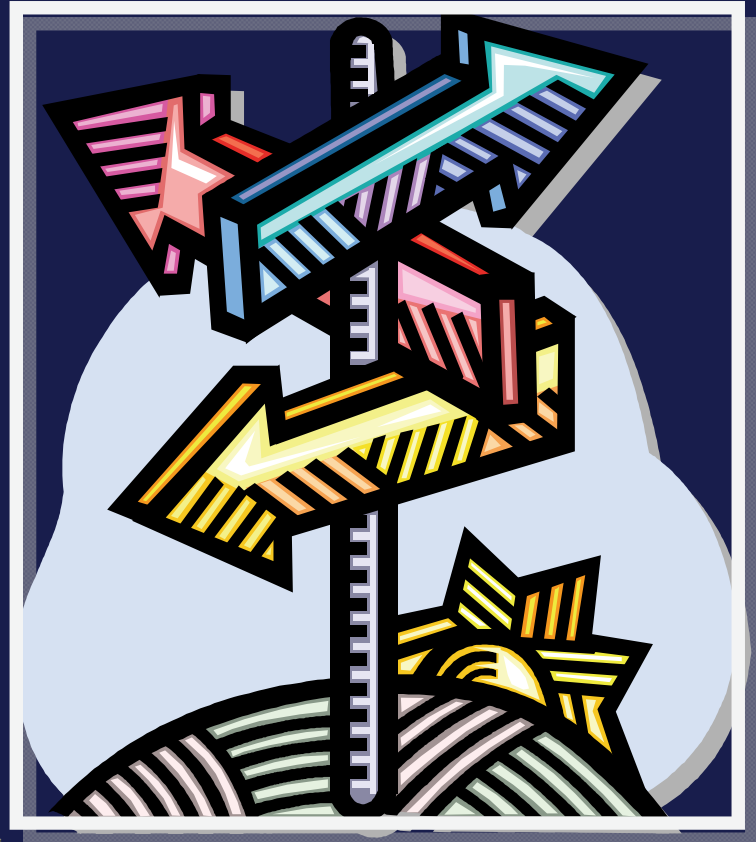

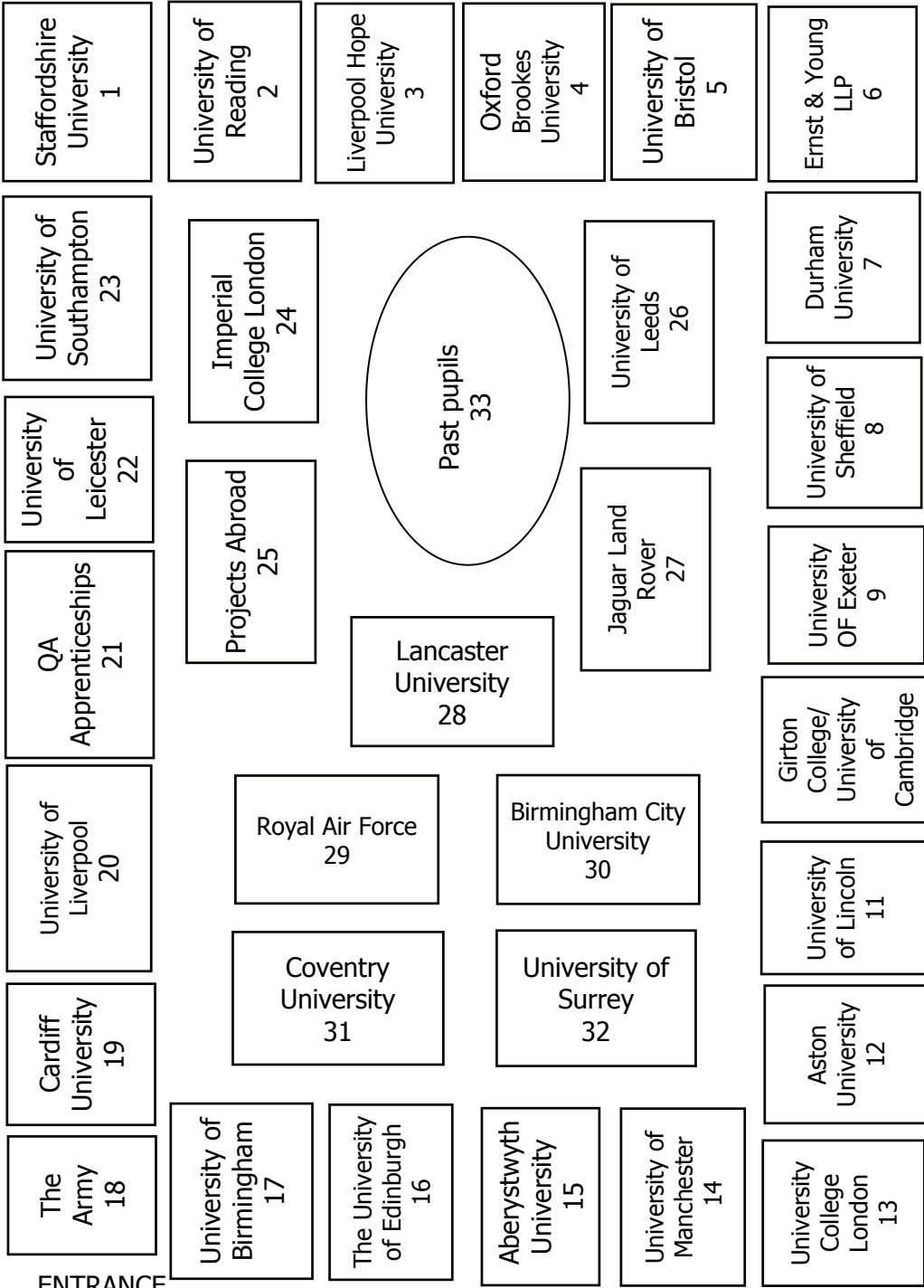
SEPTEMBER—NOVEMBER- *Individual appointments with UCAS Advisers to discuss applications.*

INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

This can be a bewildering time for students as they are faced with life-changing decisions about life beyond school. Should they go on to higher education, join a company as a trainee, or take a gap year and experience more of the world and possibly earn some money to help them through university?

Copious amounts of information are available and by the end of this academic year, we will have helped your daughters to arrive at informed choices as to their futures.

University and careers representatives as well as past pupils are available tonight for informal discussions. Over the next few months, students will be encouraged to visit universities on their open days so that they can gather information about specific courses, meet lecturers and generally get a feel for the place.
